

HOW TO TURN ON/OFF DEFERRED PROCESSING IN ISIS SERVER

After you logged in to Sinclair's ISIS server, please type:

```
cd /datatel/services/POSConnect/POSConnect_R18Test_01
```


After you are in Listener 01 please type:

```
vi POSConnect.properties
```

This will open VI text editor.

Press "**I**" button until you reach the line with `TCSPOS.deferred.processing=false`

Press "**L**" until you reach the word false beginning with f.

When the cursor is before f, please press "**I**" which will allow you to input text.

Type `true` to turn on the option or `false` to turn it off.

After you entered the word, press "**Esc**" button on your keyboard which will stop you input text.

Now we have something like "truefalse" written, we have to delete the one which is not needed. Please move the cursor with "**H**" to left or "**L**" for right. When you are at the beginning letter of the word you want to delete, press "**X**" for deleting letters. When you get the word you need, just stop please. If you deleted more than you needed, please move the cursor back and press "**I**" once again to enter the missing letters.

After you changed the word false/true please save the file by typing `":wq"`

This will also send you back to the shell prompt line.

We will need to restart the listeners in order to use the new settings. Please type

```
cd /datatel/services/POSCONNECT/scripts
```

```
./PCT.test.restart
```

Wait until all 10 listeners stop and start.

You now have the Deferred Processing on/off.

Quick guide for VI text editor.

`J` → move the cursor down

`K` → move the cursor up

`H` → move the cursor left

`L` → move the cursor right

`i` → input text

`x` → delete letter

`:wq` → this will save the changes and exit VI

`:q` → this will quit VI without saving the changes
